Purpose of Certification Review

FHWA and FTA are required to jointly review the metropolitan transportation planning process for Transportation Management Areas (TMAs) at least every 4 years

To ensure that the TMAs are following federal policies, regulations and procedures in developing the transportation planning process

- 1. **Desk Audit** a review of the products of the CRTPA.
- Site visit including discussions with: CRTPA, FDOT, transit operators; and the general public. June 25-27, 2012
- 3. <u>Final Report</u>- prepared by FHWA/FTA summarizing review findings and certification action. **June 2013**
- 4. Closeout presentation- November 18, 2013
