

Thomasville Road Multi-Use Path Feasibility Study

Project Intent

The Thomasville Road Multi-Use Path Feasibility Study is the pilot project from the **2019 Tallahassee-Leon County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan**. This project was identified as a connection between the northside of Tallahassee and Midtown, Downtown, and other areas. Existing transportation facilities on Thomasville Road do not adequately serve the existing bicycle and pedestrian network in Tallahassee and Leon County.

A review is underway to determine the feasibility of constructing a multi-use path along Thomasville Road that may be up to 12 feet wide. So far completed actions for the feasibility study include:

- » Existing Conditions Assessment
- » Field Reviews
- » Coordination with City, County, and FDOT staff

Upcoming Public Engagement

Public engagement will begin in 2021 with virtual and in-person public meetings in addition to neighborhood and stakeholder meetings.
