

## **Project Background**

This project is being completed to make walking and bicycling more convenient and safer for Tallahassee's citizens and visitors. The existing Tallahassee-Leon County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan was developed in 2004. Since that time, the City and the County have both implemented bicycle and pedestrian facilities including multi-use paths and protected bike lanes. The goal of this updated Plan is to make traveling as a bicyclist or pedestrian safer and easier within Tallahassee. Promoting safer intercity travel is another desired outcome of this Plan.

## Focus Areas for Connectivity Improvements

A series of public workshops are going to be held in destination areas of the Community. These areas include:

- Market Square and Northeast Neighborhoods
- FAMU, Southwest Area Neighborhoods
- TCC, FSU, and Downtown Tallahassee
- Midtown and Central Area Neighborhoods
- Apalachee Parkway Neighborhoods

## **Project Goals**

**Safety –** Focus on infrastructure improvements in known crash areas

**Comfort** – Reduce motorist conflict and promote shaded, easy to ride routes

Connectivity – Connect users with destinations in and around the City

Health - Promote healthier lifestyles through improved facilities and increased use

**Multimodal** – Develop usable routes for pedestrians, cyclists, and transit riders while not limiting motorists

**Equity** – Improve transportation options for disadvantaged populations and in underserved areas
