- The Leon County Workshop was held on May 20, 2014 at the Tallahassee Senior Center
- Summary of Input
  - More transportation options
  - Integrate land use and transportation
  - Create links between neighborhoods and alternate forms of transportation

# Wakulla County

- The Wakulla County Workshop was held on May 20, 2014 at the Wakulla County Commission Chambers
- Summary of Input
  - More transportation options
    - Emphasis on sidewalks near Wakulla County Senior Center
  - U.S. 319 is a top priority for the County
  - Create viable downtown Crawfordville

# Jefferson County

- The Jefferson County Workshop was held on May 22, 2014 at the County Commission Annex
- Summary of Input
  - Public transportation connection between the City of Monticello and Tallahassee
  - Bypass around Monticello
  - Downtown safety needed



# Gadsden County

- The Gadsden County Workshop was held on May 22, 2014 at the Gadsden Arts Center
- Summary of Input
  - More transportation options
  - Focus on creating jobs and drawing in new industries
  - Improve sidewalks
